Romans 12:9-18

⁹ Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. ¹⁰ Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. ¹¹ Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. ¹² Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. ¹³ Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.

¹⁴ Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. ¹⁵ Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn. ¹⁶ Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.

¹⁷ Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. ¹⁸ If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. (Romans 12:9-18 NIV)

- 3. Which of your relationships are the most encouraging? Which are the most discouraging?
- 4. Do you find the "ideal" to be a motivation for improving the "real," or are you discouraged because you don't live up to the "ideal"?
- 5. Read Romans 12:9-18. What strikes you about this passage?
- 6. Which of the relational characteristics in this passage do you find easiest to exhibit? Which are most challenging for you?
- 7. What ideas do you have for how someone can grow in these areas?
